## *From the President*

Hello Rotaractors

Because we are the only club in the ACT, and the only chartered club in this entire district, it can often feel like we are the only Rotaract club on earth. It is coming from this perspective that I have found some recent developments quite exciting. In the last few months, work has been done by various members to expand our relations with other Rotaract clubs. Since the last meeting, we had the pleasure of a visit from delegates from the five clubs in the District 9750 (which is the district immediately north of us) and some incredibly valuable connections were made, everything from how and where they get their badges done (they're hot!) all the way to inter-club activities potentially including Canberra, such as the Rotaract Ball. We also have the 40th anniversary of Rotaract being held in Melbourne next year, and as more information becomes available we can start looking at sending a group of representatives down to participate in the celebrations.

With our fellow District 9710er's, Shoalhaven, we have resurrected discussion about the Rotaractathon, with the hopes that this will once again become a regular feature on our calendars. Discussions with Shoalhaven have also included the desire of both clubs to generally increase contact, and maybe start sharing resources, such as websites, to help each club where we can. This is a very positive step forward, and while we sometimes talk about a need for Canberra to 'help' Shoalhaven become chartered, I think there is a tendency to forget that we can also look for ways that they can help us.

If you look at some of these exciting opportunities potentially happening, it can help to breath even more life into our own club as we remember that we are part of a global network of 7,300 Rotaract clubs and more than 145,000 Rotaractors. Considering all of this, the idea that we might get even more clubs functioning in the District before the end of this Rotaract Year leaves us open to huge potential for building the strength of our own club by our connection to more local clubs, but also to open the possibility for us to take on some leadership roles with the new clubs to help them establish themselves and become successful.
